The past few months have been nothing short of eventful. Many have termed this as unusual times. COVID-19 has definitely been a hot topic of discussion among all of us. Our lives and routines have been disrupted and many of our plans have been shelved. While many of us may choose to bemoan our situation, perhaps it is also a good time to take a step (or many steps) back to look at the bigger picture.

Ever since the WHO declared COVID-19 19 a pandemic, I have been thoroughly affected. I am a doctor and will be working on the front-lines when I return to work from unpaid leave. This is because I gave birth to my daughter Lucia Regina on 16th October 2019. Unfortunately, she was stillborn.

Initially, I had planned to go on unpaid leave until she would have turned 6 months old. I decided to stick to my plans as I am also currently studying for my Masters' exam. I definitely do not have a crystal ball and did not foresee this pandemic. But in retrospect, I have been blessed with the opportunity to be able to focus on my studies during a time when leave is frozen and previously accumulated leave will be potentially struck off. Even though I still carry sadness with me (and probably will for a very long time to come), I still thank God for this period of rest and recuperation.

Lucia's passing was difficult for us as a family. To this day, my husband Moses and I still wonder why we had to lose our daughter. However, we have heard accounts of how her passing moved my sister's friend who had been away from the church, to attend and offer Mass for her soul. We have also been told by others how they have been touched by Lucia and are reminded to pray more. Perhaps, God has a greater plan and our little angel has brought people back to church. In our sorrow and grief, I'm reminded that God is constantly using our daughter for His purpose and that her life wasn't in vain.


This year's Lent has been like a desert for many of us (me included). Masses are now online and as much as this situation isn't ideal, I think that these online Masses are avenues for evangelisation.
